the place of dumping should be marked with a yellow buoy and reported

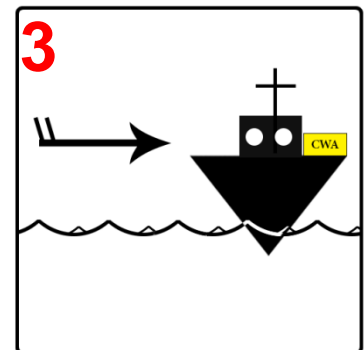
## PROCEDURES IN CASE OF EXTRACTION OF CHEMICAL MUNITION



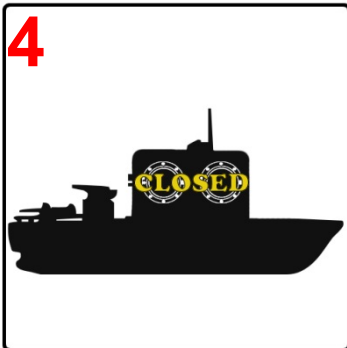

the place of extraction should be marked with a yellow buoy



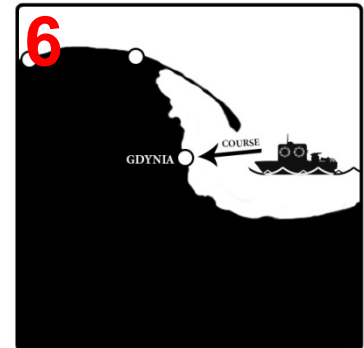

steer the vessel in such a way that contaminated places remain lee side



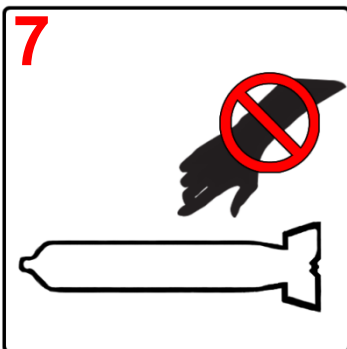

close all the openings and hatches



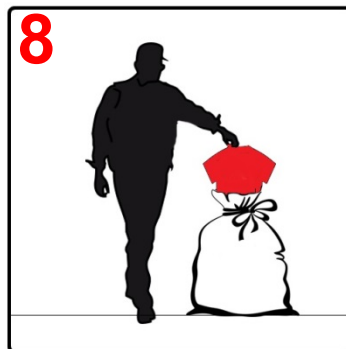
